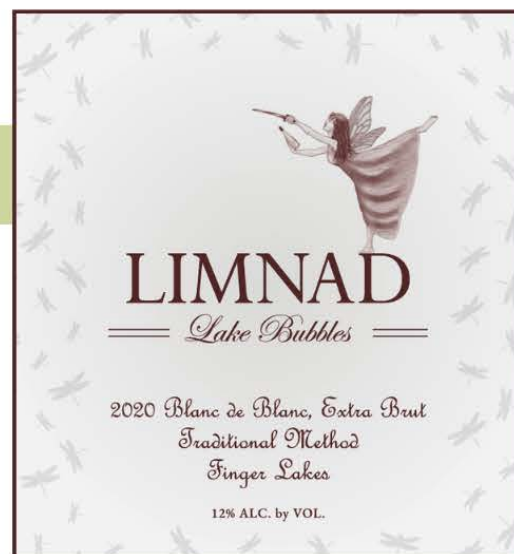

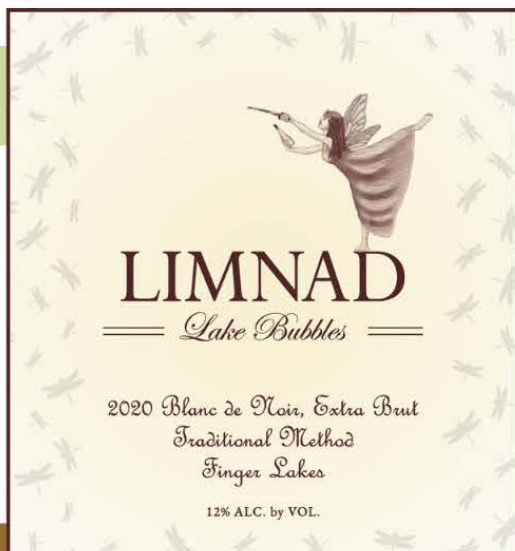

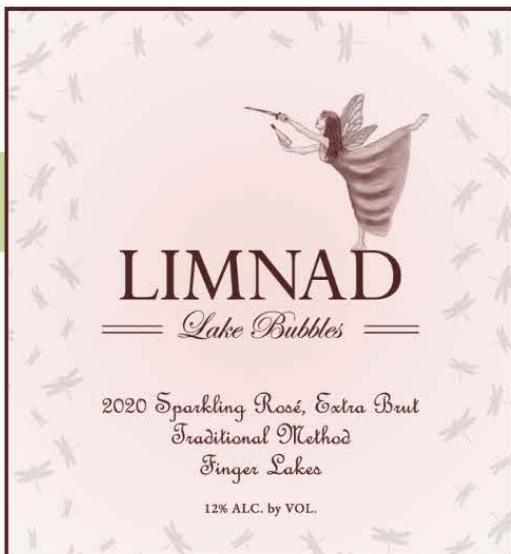


2020 Blanc de Noir

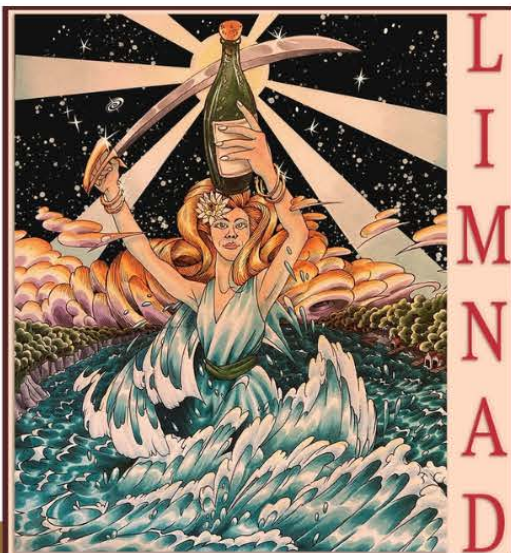
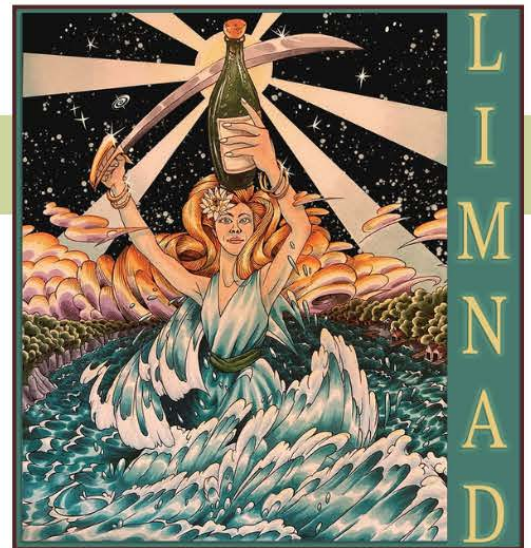
