Dedicated to organic practices, both properties are managed today by Bernard Artigue and his sons Antoine and Alexandre.

The estate was created by Paul Dubreuil at the end of the 1940s. One of his sons, Philippe, in turn settled in 1973 in the center of the village and the 2 estates were reunited in 1989 following the sudden death of Paul. It was in 2000 that the third generation came to work at the family estate but it was only in 2010 that Arnaud officially settled and took the remainder of the estate. From 10 hectares in 2010, the area is gradually increasing to now reach 12.5 hectares with the arrival on the wine list of a Corton Blanc Grand Cru "Les Grandes Lolières".

Domaine de Rochebin

Located in the heart of the Mâconnais, in Azé, Domaine de Rochebin covers more than 50 hectares of vines in the rolling hills of Southern Burgundy. Mickaël Marillier alongside his father Jean-Pierre, and Laurent Chardigny jointly manage the estate. The three men share the same philosophy and work in the same direction. The entire vineyard is managed according to the principles of sustainable management and the plots are grassed. A family estate since 1921, passed down from father to son, which turned exclusively to vines in the early 1970s. Tradition is what the estate draws inspiration from on a daily basis to work the vines. Laurent Chardigny, from which these wines are named, is the winemaker, seeking to produce wines that offer pleasure, freshness and evolved fruit aromas.

With origins dating back to 1619, the Fournié family produced wine generation after generation in this Cahors estate and were one of the first to be included in the appellation when it received AOC status in 1971. Château St-Sernin has the good fortune of vineyard sites with three distinct terroirs, from the river valley up to the plateau above, with the average vine age of 50 years. Today, Anne and Heifara manage an estate of 40 hectares of vineyards in Cahors (Malbec, Merlot, Tannat) and 6 hectares of IGP Côtes du Lot. In 2019, Château Saint-Sernin obtained the HVE – High Environmental Value (Level 3) certification, which recognizes farms engaged in particularly environmentally friendly approaches.

In the beginning of the 1960's, Jean DIOT created the champagne who would hold his name. During the following years, he cultivated the family estate with the goal to preserve the family values and their traditions. The estate was then inherited by his children in 1998. Maison Jean Diot, based in Vinay from day one, carries on the will of its founder by producing several vins de Champagne thanks to the meticulous farming of the vineyards located on the south hills of Epernay and in the Marne's valley. A unique savoir-faire connects the vine to the wine-grower who takes care of the grape in any circumstances, the vines in return offer their most sumptuous grapes for the making of exceptional champagnes. Whole year long, the wine growing artisans look after the vineyards, to the delicate perfume of the vine variety : Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay; each of them bringing their own characteristics and subtleties.

Passionate winegrowers in the heart of the Loire Valley, at the foot of the hills of the AOC Chinon, Philippe and his daughters Clothilde and Honorine operate around fifty hectares of vines under organic conversion, according to tradition and respect for the environment. Surrounded by Cabernet Franc and Chenin in the communes of Panzoult and Cravant les Coteaux, the Pain family produces convivial wines as well as exceptional cuvées. The macerations practiced accentuate the varietal expression of the Loire grape varieties for more typicality. With a rigorous aging in carefully selected barrels in the cellar, some cuvées surprise with their finesse and exoticism. It is at the rhythm of the vegetative cycle of the vine, and by practicing vinification that respects the harvest that they have found their place in the heart of the Chinon vineyards.

Located less than half a mile from the famous Château de Cheverny, Domaine Le Portail, once a monastery, is now a family-owned wine estate, run by Delphine and Damien Cadoux. Planted on siliceous clay soil, Domaine Le Portail consists of 32 hectares of vineyards, two of which grow the rare and ancient Romarantin grape in the Cour-Cheverny Appellation. The vines are cultivated and vinified the traditional way to preserve their authenticity and promote the terroir, producing aromatic and refined wines. Since 2000, the vineyards have adopted viticulture and wine production practices respectful of the environment and in compliance with the French sustainability organization Terra Vitis.

Located on the east of the village of Vinsobres, protected from the Mistral winds, the vineyards of Domaine Saint Vincent inhabit the land of the former convent of Saint Césaire de Nyons, where a chapel was erected in memory of Saint Vincent, the patron saint of winegrowers. It was in this privileged place that in the 1920's, the Domaine Saint Vincent was created. Today Philippe Lescoche and his daughter Ludivine, grow and develop the estate with great passion for the wines and the historical significance of this ancient land. The estate covers 50 hectares of vines. It is mainly constituted of Grenache and Syrah grapes, emblematic varieties of the Rhône Valley. The vine is organically cultivated with perseverance and dedication with respect for ancestral tradition and the environment. Oriented North East / South West and culminating at an altitude of more than 500 meters, the terroir of the Vinsobres hills are characterized by a great diversity of soils. Their potentiality and richness give wines great complexity. The Vinsobres terroir is expressed its strong Syrah grape variety which gives the wine its remarkable freshness and its spicy side.

Weingut Nikolaus Köwerich is located on the Central Mosel, nestling on a particularly beautiful river bend between Trier and Bernkastel. The valley is sun-drenched, and this landscape, characterized by blue Devonian slate, has been growing wine here for two millennia. Riesling has been grown on the Mosel since 1465 and the Köwerich family has been listed in the town's parish register since 1548. For them, they believe that tradition belongs in the bottle, and not on it. That's why they choose unconventional names for many of their Rieslings. Nevertheless, just like their ancestors, they live by the rhythm of the vines and are allowed to produce something that accompanies humankind's magical moments.

The Hirt-Gebhardt winery has its origin in the center of the traditional wine village of Martinthal in the Rheingau, where the Gebhardt winemaking family has been mentioned in documents since the end of the 30-year war. Through marriage, the present name of the winery was created in 1948. Over time, Christian Gebhardt, today's senior, with his wife Elke and the support of his parents, has grown a flourishing winery with 23 hectares of vineyards from a small family business. Today, his son Christian Gebhardt Jr. is the owner of the company and thus follows in his father's footsteps. He and his wife Claire continue the family's winemaking tradition together. In order to withstand the structural change and further development in viticulture, they have decided to relocate from the narrow town in Martinthal to the Eltviller Sonnenberg. With a lot of work, heart and soul and above all the support of a strong family, they have set up their new winery in Eltville.

Up to the 2019 vintage, the winery has been managed by Hans Joachim Gebert for more than 30 years. In the fifth generation, he restructured the farm from a mixed operation to a pure viticultural focus at the beginning of his career, developed the site portfolio to 28 parcels in four single vineyards to form a coherent collection, and shaped the flavor profile through quality standards and stylistics in the vineyard and cellar. There are hardly more combinations of subsoil, slope, wind direction, solar radiation and precipitation than in Rheinhessen. This multitude of microclimatic differences is particularly reflected in our four small parcel vineyard sites. Besides this diversity, defining the right grape varieties, lineages and weather-related different working steps in each case is what “terroir” means to us.

Sustainable

Passomadama wines are born from the idea of the new generation of the Barba family. The family, with traces back to the fifteenth century, has been active for decades in the field of agriculture with one main goal: to enhance their best vineyards and make the most out of them. Barba is situated in an area with a profound agricultural position, an undulating landscape with large bumps of almost flat and rounded sides, often interrupted by steep slopes favored by a mild and bright climate. Here, the summer offers long sunny days alternated with cool nights, whereas winter is mitigated by the influence of the nearby Adriatic Sea. This project includes about 20 hectares of vineyards placed in particularly suitable areas at about 300 meters above sea level. This location allows to obtain grapes with great potential and extremely interesting wines. Abruzzo is a fascinating region, rich in landscapes and soils. Not only the beaches and mountains very well known to tourists, but also lakes, rivers, plateaus and valleys, hills. And it is precisely on one of these hills that flank the Vomano River Valley that the vineyards from which Passomadama wines are produced are located. These grapes grow at medium altitudes, in one of the most suitable areas in the district of Teramo, in the heart of the Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Trebbiano d'Abruzzo, Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo and Colline Teramane Docg production areas. It is the first plant of modern espalier vineyards with vines obtained from decades of clonal selection carried out by the family. The project for the next few years is to plant new vineyards at altitudes above 400 meters in order to make it possible for the grapes to ripen more gradually and, therefore, in order to fight the negative effects of climate change. During the harvest, the grapes are collected in boxes and carefully selected to be vinified in the cellar. The staff has the task of taking care of grapes and musts at all stages of winemaking in order to obtain pleasant, fruity, and elegant wines. Everything happens under the constant and qualified supervision of Dr. Stefano Chioccioli, Internationally renowned winemaker. Although the identity of these wines is rooted in this territory and its traditions, the modern, versatile and dynamic style of the new Barba generation and the Passomadama project is very well recognizable.

Anacleto Bonelli founded the winery in the mid 40s, right after the war. In what could be defined today as a pioneering move, he built an activity that was extremely thoughtful of the surrounding territory by creating a network of vine growers in the Trebbia Valley and producing a new, distinctive wine, which reflected and valorized the peculiarities of the area: the Trebbianino Val Trebbia, produced with autochthonous grapes. What Anacleto pioneered almost 75 years ago is defined today as sustainability, by supporting the local community, Cantine Bonelli allows the valley to thrive and encourage future generations of growers to remain in their home region. The activity he started has been flourishing for three generations, and the family still follows his example by working with the same passion and dedication. The Trebbia Valley is a hilly area that constitutes a balanced ecosystem of vineyards alternated to woodlands and crops, making up a perfect model of biodiversity. The gravelly soil is the most ancient of all the surrounding areas and is overlooked by majestic magmatic peaks such as the Pietra Parcellara. Cantine Bonelli focuses on indigenous varietals such as Ortrugo, Malvasia di Candia, Bonarda (Croatina) and Barbera. The viticultural practices, sustainable to minimize environmental impact, maintain low yields, employ hand harvesting while the sugar, acid and taste are all in optimum balance. This allows the unique terroir to show through in each vintage.
